## Course Description

### Preparation course for the Ministry of Transport for Ontario's M2 Exit Test

This course is designed to assist those wanting to prepare themselves for the M2 examination taken at the Ministry of Transport for Ontario (MTO) Driver Examination Centre. During this examination, the MTO examiner will direct you over a specific route and observe your riding competence and your ability to ride safely and defensively. The route includes residential, business area and riding on a freeway. The test marking of the examiner is based on the information in the MTO Motorcycle Rider Handbook.

**Remember this is a lecture course only. Each student will be responsible for booking their own appointment at the Ministry of Transportation, for their M2 Exit Riding Test.**

During the Preparation Course, a certified M2 exit Signing Authority, will guide you through the examination requirements. **The handbook for this course will not be supplied. If you wish to purchase one, please add \$16 to the fee.**

During the evening, you will be oriented to the contents of the examination with the emphasis on relating required riding skills to examination requirements. You will also be talked through one of the M2 exit test examination elements in detail, with an explanation of what driver examiners will be marking during the test.

While there are no guarantees, this program should go a long way towards your understanding of what will be required. From our experience, the majority of those who have failed the Ministry's test, did not fail because of a lack of riding skill, but because they were not aware of the examination requirements.
