

RoadSafety Scavenger Hunt

Suitable for kids
in Grades 1 – 6

- A traffic light
- A stop sign
- A yield sign
- A pedestrian light
- A vehicle with its back-up lights on
- A pedestrian cross-over
- A pedestrian doing something dangerous (ex. listening to headphones)
- A driver doing something dangerous (ex. talking on their cell phone)
- A street with a sidewalk
- A street without a sidewalk
- Someone wearing something reflective.
- A cyclist on the street (considered a “vehicle”)
- A cyclist riding on the sidewalk (considered a “pedestrian”)
- A driver making eye contact with you.
- A visual barrier (something that blocks you from seeing
 drivers or drivers from seeing you)
- BONUS! An emergency vehicle (either hear the siren or see it)
